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Actively Recruiting Research Studies

Decreased Sexual Desire Studies:

-National Registry of Women with Decreased Sexual Desire (known as Hypoactive Sexual Desire Disorder or HSDD) [No study related treatment or medication]

-A Novel Non-hormonal Therapy for Decreased Sexual Desire (known as Hypoactive Sexual Desire Disorder or HSDD) in **Premenopausal Women**

-A Novel Non-hormonal Therapy for Decreased Sexual Desire (known as Hypoactive Sexual Desire Disorder or HSDD) in **Postmenopausal** Women

-Testosterone Gel Therapy in the Treatment of Decreased Sexual Desire (known as Hypoactive Sexual Desire Disorder or HSDD) in **Postmenopausal** Women after Hysterectomy with Removal of the Ovaries

-Testosterone Gel in the Treatment of Decreased Sexual Desire (known as Hypoactive Sexual Desire Disorder or HSDD) in **Postmenopausal** Women with Cardiac Risk Factors (high blood pressure, elevated cholesterol, etc.)

Oral Contraception Studies:

-Oral Contraceptives for the Prevention of Pregnancy in Normal Sexually Active Women who are at Risk for Pregnancy

-Oral Contraceptives for the Prevention of Menstrually Related Migraine Headaches

-Oral Contraceptive Use in Adolescents (12-18y): Impact on Peak Bone Density

Menopausal Symptom Studies:

-Vaginal DHEA (a naturally occurring pre-hormone) in the Treatment of Postmenopausal Vulvar/Vaginal Atrophy

-An Oral SERM (a non-estrogenic drug which acts like an estrogen or anti-estrogen depending upon the tissue [SERM]) for the Treatment of Moderate to Severe Postmenopausal Hot Flashes (VMS)
